Team Rules & Parent Conduct

General

TEAM GAME: Hockey is a team game. Each player is expected to encourage and cheer on their teammates. Always work for the good of the team.

COMMITMENT: Every player will make their commitment to the Team, its programs and goals a major priority.

DO NOT CRITICIZE: No player will criticize another player on the bench, in the dressing room or any other place either to his face or behind his back.

PRACTICE HARD: Learn every time you step on the ice. Dedication to learning is best demonstrated by a serious attitude at practice, the repetitive hard work required to learn new skills, individual tactics, and team tactics and strategies.

ATTITUDE: is often the key factor in separating good players/good teams from great players/great teams. Play for the love of the game

INJURIES: If you are injured, tell the coaching staff immediately so that proper attention will be given to the injury.

100% EFFORT: Make sure when you come off the ice after every shift you know you have given 100% of your utmost ability.

Be **GENEROUS** in winning and **GRACEFUL** in losing.

Conduct yourself with **HONOUR** and **DIGNITY** when representing the **TIGERS** Organization.

Always be **FAIR** and display **SPORTSMANSHIP**. Be obedient to the rules.

Appearance

PUNCTUALITY: It is important that all players arrive at the Arena a minimum 1 hour prior to game, and 20 minutes prior to practice.

BE READY: All players must be in full uniform and ready for the team talk 10 minutes prior to the start of the game/practice.

ABSENT: Absenteeism must be reported to one of the coaching staff 24 hours prior to the game/practice, with the exception of an emergency.

FULL EQUIPMENT: If you are missing equipment, you must notify the coaching staff immediately. If equipment is not available, the coaching staff may judge that you cannot play in the interest of your own safety.

Parental Conduct

PARENTAL INTERFERENCE: Will not be tolerated while a player is playing in a game or working in practice.

OFFICIALS: No parent is to protest a decision of the officials or in any way communicate with them.

COMMUNICATION: All observations and advice by parents is solicited and are welcome, however, please approach any one of the coaching staff in *private*. If you are *upset* at anything, please talk to us after *24 hours* has elapsed so we can address the problem when we are cool and rational.

OTHER PLAYERS: Their affairs will not be discussed with any parent. Only circumstances relating to your own son or the entire team can be discussed.
