## Player/Parent/Coach Code of Conduct and Rules

This is a short summary of rules and guidelines that we will use to create our winning culture. A more detailed list will be presented to the final team after tryouts.

#### **Obligations of the Coaches**

- Provide a safe, fun environment where the players can develop both as teammates and individuals.
- Provide the necessary coaching and leadership that will enable each player to develop their hockey skills to the best of their ability.
- Set goals for the team and individuals and establish a plan to achieve these goals

#### Obligations of the Player

- Show up on time and prepared to give 100% effort while respecting players, coaches, parents and
  officials
- School work comes first, maintain good grades.
- Always listen to coaches and be willing to try new things, a different position, a new line-mate etc.
- Play the game hard but fair. Win with class and lose with dignity.
- <u>Players</u> are responsible for bringing all equipment to practices and games. Players are carrying their own hockey bag and dressing themselves including tying up skates.
- Be dressed and ready 10 minutes before scheduled practice start time.
- Practice jerseys and practice socks will be worn during practices.
- Arrive at the arena 60 min before game time.
- Adhere to the team dress code for all games.
- Electronics of any kind should not be played in the dressing room aside from music before a game.
- Be prepared and participate in the team warm-up prior to each game.
- TEAM play and attitude is required at all times.

### **Obligations of the Parents**

- Ensure that your Tiger arrives a minimum of sixty (60) minutes prior to each game. Please ensure your Tiger is dressed and ready minimum 10 minutes prior to the start of practice.
- Please follow the 24 hour rule for any inquires to the coach involving an incident that may occur unless the conversation related to player safety and needs to happen immediately.
- Parents and siblings, uncles, cousins, and pets are not permitted in the dressing room before or after a practice or a game.
- Support the coaching staff's philosophy and the importance of team play and effort.
- Represent the team in a respectful manner at all times.
- All parents are expected to refrain from the use of social media to voice opinions on this team or any member of the team.
